PUTNAM COUNTY SOIL AND WATER STRIVES TOWARD INDEPENDENCE

As a member of the Board of Supervisors for the Putnam County Soil and Water Conservation District (SWCD), Kerry Ames is looking toward the future. “The SWCD plays a vital role in our ability to preserve our soil and water for our children and grandchildren in Putnam County, said Ames. “As this world becomes more populated, it will depend increasingly upon farmers in the Heartland to generate food and protect potable water.”

SWCD has traditionally received financial support from the United States federal government. But over the years, the county has seen its allocation reduced. In an effort to build local independence from state and federal control, Ames voted to establish an endowment administered by the Putnam County Community Foundation. Eventually it is hoped that the endowment will support a full time county educator/executive director. Contributions to the endowment will be matched 50% by the Putnam County Community Foundation.
