General Scholarships

Alpha Gamma Delta-Eta Alumnae Chapter Scholarship – Award varies; must reapply – DUE MARCH 15

Eligibility: Junior or senior at an accredited Indiana college or university; minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0.

Asbury Towers Endowment for Continuing Education in Nursing – Award \$250; must reapply

Eligibility: Full-time Asbury Towers' employee for six months; high school diploma or GED; pursuing continuing education or licensure in nursing.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application; provide two letters of reference (one from supervisor at Asbury Towers).

Betty L. & Marjorie Dierdorf Memorial Scholarship – Award \$1,000; one-time award

Eligibility: Current Putnam County, Clay County, or Knox County High School senior; unweighted high school GPA of 2.5 to 3.7.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Clinton Township Scholarship - Award \$250 per semester, up to a maximum of eight consecutive semesters (\$2,000)

Eligibility: Resident of Clinton Township at high school graduation and for two of four high school years; demonstrated scholastic abilities, financial need, and citizenship; high school senior who has applied and been accepted as a full or part-time student at an accredited technical school, community college, or traditional college or university; pursuing a two-year or four-year degree. Continuation of award is contingent upon student remaining enrolled **and** maintaining a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Evans Family Culver Academy Scholarship – Award varies; must reapply

Eligibility: Putnam County resident, accepted for admission to Culver Academies (grades 9 through 12), or Culver Summer Schools.

Cindy & John Hennette Dental Scholarship – Award \$1,000; must reapply

Eligibility: Putnam County resident; intends to pursue a career in dentistry or dental hygiene; minimum high school GPA of 2.5; award based on merit, financial need, moral character, and community or volunteer service.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Heritage Lake Scholarship Fund – Award varies; one-time award

Eligibility: Permanently reside with a Heritage Lake Property Owners Association voting member or associate member; top 50% of graduating class by the end of the first semester of senior year; community service participation documented on Heritage Lake Community Service Form; two letters of reference, one from high school guidance department.

H.O.P. Technologies Academic Scholarship – Award \$500; one-time award

Eligibility: Putnam County high school senior excelling in academics, community service, and leadership.

Eligibility: Putnam County high school senior excelling in athletics, community service, and leadership.

Kiwanis Club of Greencastle Indiana State Police Career Camp Scholarship – Award covers cost of attendance at Indiana State Police Career Camp; may reapply— APPLICATION DUE MARCH 30

Eligibility: Teen aged 14-17 (grades 9-12); participant in law enforcement classes at Area 30; willing to provide a written and/or oral report of their experiences. Volunteer and service work, particularly in Key Club or other positions of leadership and responsibility are preferred.

Kiwanis Club of Greencastle Key Leader Weekend Scholarship -- Award covers cost of attendance at Key Leader Retreat; may reapply; APPLICATION DUE MARCH 30

Eligibility: Teen aged 14-17 (grades 9-12); Putnam County resident and/or attending a Putnam County high school; applicants seeking to become Key Leader Student Facilitators must be a graduate of a previous Key Leader retreat and either a Junior or Senior in high school; willing to provide a written and/or oral report of their experiences. Volunteer and service work, particularly in Key Club or other positions of leadership and responsibility are preferred.

Lilly Endowment Community Scholarship – Full tuition & fees for 4 yrs at Indiana college or university

Eligibility: Putnam County resident for at least two years including senior year; graduating senior of a Putnam County high school or of a regionally accredited Indiana high school by June 2012; excellence in academics (minimum unweighted GPA of 3.3, pursuing Academic Honors Diploma, combined minimum SAT score of 1600 or comparable ACT score of 23), leadership, and extracurricular achievements. Meets requirements for admission and intends to pursue a Baccalaureate degree beginning in the fall of 2012 on a full-time basis at any Indiana college or university accredited by the Higher Learning Commission of the North Central Association of Colleges and Schools.

Lisa Stringer Thies Memorial Scholarship – Award \$500; must reapply

Eligibility: Graduate of a Putnam County High School with community involvement, pursuing a two, four or graduate degree in an area of service to the physically disabled; minimum GPA of 2.5.

Lyon Family Scholarship – Award up to \$10,000 per year for 2 years; must reapply after second year

Eligibility: Adults and youth; residents of Putnam County, accepted for admission or currently enrolled as a full or part-time student at an accredited technical school, community college, or traditional college or university; pursuing a two-year, four-year or graduate degree. Financial need is considered.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Marjorie B. Oliver Fund for Nursing Scholarships – Award \$1,000 per semester; renewable up to 4 years

Eligibility: Putnam County resident, pursuing a career in nursing.

Putnam County Board of Realtors Scholarship – Award \$500; one-time award

Eligibility: Putnam County high school graduate; attending a 2-4 year institution of higher education pursuing a career in business, finance, real estate or law; minimum GPA of 3.0.

Putnamville Correctional Facility Memorial Scholarship – Up to \$1,400; may reapply

Eligibility: An employee OR the legal dependent of an employee of Putnamville Correctional Facility, pursuing a career in law enforcement, corrections, or related areas. Preference given to employees.

Roscoe & Flossie N. Zeiner Scholarship – Award up to \$10,000 per year; one-year award; recipient may receive award up to four years; must re-apply annually

Eligibility: Graduate of Putnam County High School, may be a graduating senior OR an adult returning to school; financial need, personal hardship, and ability, desire, and work-ethic necessary to succeed in a career. Preference given to prior recipients.

Finalists are nominated by guidance staff and/or academic advisor.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

St. Paul the Apostle Ladies Guild Scholarship – Award up to \$500; must reapply

Eligibility: Member of St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church; Putnam County high school senior; minimum high school GPA of 3.0; participation in extracurricular activities.

Stockton Hospice Educational Foundation – Award up to \$250; one-time award

Eligibility: Hospice employee of at least one year, working in one of the counties served by Horizon Hospice Care, Inc. of Indiana; employee merit, years of hospice employment, and volunteer service considered.

Tri -Kappa Scholarship—Award varies; must reapply

Eligibility: Female resident of Putnam County; minimum 20 years old; minimum GPA 2.0; intended for a sophomore college student or above; may be used for undergraduate or graduate program. Preference given to non-traditional students.

4-H Scholarships

Applicants may apply for all four scholarships but may be awarded only one scholarship annually. The scholarships are to be used at any accredited college, university, vocational/trade school, two-year degree program, or short course. NOTE: Only one copy of “My Record of Achievement” is needed.

4-H General Scholarship – Award varies; one-time award

Eligibility: Current college student with a minimum of C average; applicants must have been Putnam County 4-H members who were active during the last five years of 4-H eligibility with a history of community service. Attach current “My Record of Achievement”.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

4-H Livestock Scholarship – Award varies; one-time award

Eligibility: Current college student with a minimum of C average; applicants must have been Putnam County 4-H members involved with a livestock project who were active during the last five years of 4-H eligibility with a history of community service. Attach current “My Record of Achievement”.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Barbara & Edward Brookshire 4-H Scholarship – Award varies; must reapply

Eligibility: Graduating high school senior or current college student with a minimum of C average; applicants must have been Putnam County 4-H members who were active during the last five years of 4-H eligibility with a history of community service. The five year period may include the current year’s 4-H membership. Financial need may be considered. Attach current “My Record of Achievement”.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Darrel Thomas 4-H Scholarship – Award varies; one-time award

Eligibility: Current college student with a minimum of C average; applicants must have been Putnam County 4-H members who were active during the last five years of 4-H eligibility with a history of community service. Attach current “My Record of Achievement”.

To Apply for a Scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Cloverdale High School Scholarships

Cloverdale Community Scholarship – Award \$500; one-time award

Eligibility: Cloverdale High School senior.

Greencastle High School Scholarships

Brian John & Roberta (Berdee) Lanie Memorial Scholarship – Up to \$1,000; renewable to 4 years, must reapply

Eligibility: Greencastle High School graduate; participation in a variety of extracurricular activities; minimum high school unweighted GPA of 3.0; must attest to being drug and alcohol free.

Francis & Betty Hamilton Memorial Scholarship – Award up to \$600; must reapply

Eligibility: Greencastle High School graduate; Indiana University student enrolled in pre-law or law program.

Greencastle Community Schools Educational Endowment – Award \$300; one-time award

Eligibility: Greencastle High School senior or graduate; minimum high school GPA of 3.0.

Greencastle High School Alumni Scholarship – Award \$800 - \$1,000; must reapply; DUE MARCH 15

Eligibility: Greencastle High School graduate who attended at least two years at Greencastle High School; full-time enrollment in institution of higher learning; financial need; good citizenship.

Murray & Sara Pride Scholarship Endowment - Award up to \$1,000; one-time award

Eligibility: Resident of one of the six Northern Townships of Putnam County; North Putnam High School graduating senior; minimum unweighted cumulative GPA of 2.5; post-secondary institution with a preferred field of education; displaying the following traits: honesty, strong work ethic, volunteerism, commitment to community, participation in extracurricular activities, community service and a variety of interests.

Honorary award; no application; nominated by school administration.

North Putnam Community Schools Scholarship Endowment - Award up to \$800; one-time award

Eligibility: North Putnam High School graduating senior; minimum of Core 40 diploma; minimum unweighted GPA of 3.0; enrolled in a 2-4 year post-secondary institution; financial need; involvement in extracurricular activities; good citizenship; community service.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

Russell Township Alumni Scholarship – Award up to \$1,500; one-time award; DUE MARCH 1

Eligibility: North Putnam High School graduate; resident of Russell Township.

To apply for a scholarship: Complete the Community Foundation application.

South Putnam High School Scholarships

Belle Union High School Alumni Association Scholarship – Award up to \$700; one-time award

Eligibility: South Putnam High School graduating senior attending minimum of Jr. and Sr. years at SPSHS; scholastic abilities; leadership; extracurricular activities; moral character; applicant must document a direct tie to Belle Union High School with at least one relative who was a graduate (attach separate sheet with names and years attended); intends to be enrolled as full-time undergraduate student.

Fillmore High School Alumni Association Scholarship – Award \$500; one-time award; DUE MARCH 31

Eligibility: South Putnam High School graduate attending minimum of two years at SPSHS; preference for students pursuing vocational training; financial need; moral character. Preference will be given to graduates of Fillmore Elementary School, Fillmore, Indiana OR to applicants that document a direct tie to Fillmore High School, e.g. mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, great-grandmother or great-grandfather were graduates of Fillmore High School. The number of generational ties is not relevant, one is sufficient.
